

The CareOregon Advantage (COA) Dental Flex Card

What dental practices need to know

What it is

- As part of the COA benefit package, all COA members receive a \$1,500 Dental Flex Card to help pay for dental items and services that Medicaid does not cover.
- The card can be used to help pay for recommended services like crowns, root canals and replacement of dentures when ineligible due to frequency limitations.

How it works

- Members should continue to see their primary Medicaid dental provider for all covered services.
- If a members' treatment plan includes services with costs not covered by Medicaid, the Dental Flex Card can be used in the same manner as self-pay, for up to \$1,500 in expenses. The card can be used in both in-network Medicaid and out-of-network, non-Medicaid dental offices.
- The card can also be used for covered services that will deny for frequency limitations and for items like toothbrushes and other home care items sold in your dental office.
- The card swipes just like any prepaid card – it should be run like a credit card.
- Cards must be activated before any attempted transactions take place. If the member attempts to redeem before activation, it can lock the card. If card becomes locked, call VISA customer service at 833-614-3258.

Important information

- Medicaid providers can only charge members for non-covered services.
- The OHP Client Agreement to Pay for Health Services form should be completed prior to charging a member and accepting any payment, including the Dental Flex Card. The agreement can be found here: link.careoregon.org/OHP-health-services-client-agreement
- If the cost of non-covered services is greater than the balance on the member's card, the member is responsible for the remainder of the payment. The total cost should be reflected on the OHP Client Agreement to Pay for Health Services form.
- It is best practice for providers to complete the Prior Authorization process with the members' dental plan to check for OHP coverage authorization prior to charging the member.
- Providers are not required to submit encounters for services that are paid for with the Dental Flex Card.



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The fine print

- The member must be eligible with CareOregon Advantage at the time of payment. The card is deactivated when the patient is no longer an active COA member.
- Any unused funds on the card expire on 12/31 of each year.
- The card is non-transferrable.
- The card can be used anywhere in the United States. It cannot be used internationally.
- Refunds are to be applied back to the card.
- The card can be used in any dental clinic, based on Merchant Category Classification (MCC) Codes on your VISA machine. If the card does not work in your office, yet the member has verified a positive balance, contact CareOregon Advantage at 503-416-4279 or 888-712-3258.
